

KORE1001 Korean I.1(6 credits)

Registration Issue

1. KORE1001 is designed for complete beginners in the study of the Korean language who intend to major and minor in Korean Studies.
2. Major in Korean Studies or Minor in Korean studies:
 - ① For Year 1 students:
 - Registration of KORE1001, KORE1002, and KORE1021 in this academic year can be a factor to be considered for the selection. However, only expressing the intention does not guarantee approval for the course.
 - ② For Year 2-4 students:
 - a) Declaration of the major or minor and b) registration of KORE1001, KORE1002, and KORE1021 in this academic year can be a factor to be considered for the selection. However, only expressing the intention does not guarantee approval for the course.
 - In addition, please be aware that it requires at least three years to complete the major and the minor.
 - Declaration of the major or minor with an unrealistic study plan (including dropping the declaration just after approval of registration) may affect the application unfavorably even leading to the revocation of approval.
3. KORE1001 is designed for the complete beginner so students with previous knowledge of the Korean language **MUST TAKE A PLACEMENT TEST** for an appropriate level. The sign-up link for the placement test will be on the KORE1001 Moodle on September 1.
4. Regardless of your registration status, during the add/drop period, you **MUST attend all classes from September 1**, as a full load of teaching will be delivered from the first day of the new semester.
5. Please note that **WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REPLY** to any individual inquiry about your application result, the status of the application process, the reason for disapproval, or appeal for reconsideration after being disapproved. However, until the add/drop period ends, the possibility of being approved by keeping on re-applying remains as an option.
